
Felling / removal of fruit trees, in addition to other trees, is often required for execution of different developmental programme of the State Govt and the Central Govt as well. In such a situation, compensation has to be paid to the land owners of the affected land having growth of fruit trees. The Govt. of Odisha is hereby pleased to formulate the following Standard Operating Procedure for provision of compensation as mentioned hereunder for effective execution of development works. The compensation value in respect of 27 nos. different fruit trees in case of felling/ removal for implementation of different Govt. programme is enclosed herewith vide annexure-I.

1. The compensation for fruit crops, to be affected by any developmental project, will be provided to project affected individuals (herein after called the claimant) having raised fruit crops on their own private land. No compensation for fruit trees, to be affected by any developmental project, will be provided for fruit crops raised by private individuals on any Govt. land, Panchayat or Societies land etc.
2. The Claimant shall intimate the concerned Land Acquisition Officer regarding details of land affected under the project with ownership claim providing ROR & other supporting documents.
3. The Land Acquisition Officer shall intimate, under intimation to the Claimant, the Tahasildar , the DDH & the DFO concerned as regards the claim of the Claimant .
4. The competent officials of DDH, DFO & Tahasildar shall fix a suitable date under intimation to the Claimant and the project proponent for Joint verification of the trees in the project affected land.
5. The Joint verification report shall be submitted to the Land Acquisition Officer & the Land Acquisition Officer shall send a copy of the report to the DDH & DFO concerned.
6. The DDH shall determine the compensation value of the fruit trees of the affected land on the basis of Joint verification report & the Govt. approved compensation value and intimate that to Land Acquisition Officer under intimation to Claimant.
7. Compensation shall be provided to Claimants directly in their bank account linked with AADHAR through DBT mode by the project proponent.
8. The DFO shall issue felling permission of the jointly enumerated trees of the affected land & take possession of the felled material as per the prevailing rule / procedure of the Forest Deptt. & the sale value of the felled material after deducting the working cost shall accrue to the project proponent.
9. Any grievance relating to the compensation value of the fruit trees shall be placed before the DDH of the district concerned. Any person, not satisfied with the decision on compensation value taken by the DDH of district, may prefer an appeal before the Director of Horticulture as **Appellate Authority** and the decision of Director of Horticulture, Odisha, Bhubaneswar shall be binding.
10. Grievances relating to compensation of trees other than fruit trees shall be placed before the DFO concerned for redressal of the same.

11. This **compensation value** shall be effective from the date of issue of this notification.
