Qualifications

1. Professor of Economics

Essential:

An eminent scholar with published work of high quality, actively engaged in research, with 10 years of experience in postgraduate teaching and/or experience in research at the University/National Level institutions, including experience of guiding research at doctoral level.

OR

An outstanding scholar with established reputation who has made significant contribution to knowledge.

In exceptional cases, the teachers with 15 years of U.G. teaching/research experience could also be considered.

Desirable:

- a) Capability of undertaking independent research in collaboration with national and international organizations.
- b) Ability to supervise and guide doctoral research leading to Ph.D.
- c) Ability to mobilize funds for research activities from government and other national and international organizations.
- d) Preference will be given to candidates having experience in conducting research studies of similar institutions and willing to participate in research programme.
- e) Familiarity with computer and statistical packages.
- f) Experience in Quantitative and Applied Economics.

2. Reader in Economics

Essential:

Good academic record with a doctoral degree or equivalent published work. In addition to these, candidates who join from outside the university system, shall also possess at least 55% of the marks or equivalent grade of B in the 7 point scale with latter grades O,A,B,C,D,E, and F at the Master's degree level.

Five years of experience of teaching and/or research excluding the period spent for obtaining the research degrees and has made some mark in the areas of scholarship as evidenced by quality of publications, contribution to educational innovation, design of new courses and curricula.

Desirable:

- a) Capability of undertaking independent research in collaboration with national and international organizations.
- b) Ability to supervise and guide doctoral research leading to Ph.D.
- c) Ability to mobilize funds for research activities from government and other national and international organizations.
- d) Preference will be given to candidates having experience in conducting research studies of similar institutions and willing to participate in research programme.

Scales of Pay:

Professor in Economics: Rs.37,400 – 67,000 + AGP Rs.10,000/-

Reader in Economics: Rs. 15,600 – 39,100 + AGP Rs. 8,000/-

In addition dearness allowance and HRA are admissible as per rule. The incumbent shall get the CPF-cum-Gratuity or pension-cum-Gratuity as per the Service Conditions of the Centre.

Other Conditions

1. The period of probation shall be one year at the first instance.

2. No deputation allowance shall be paid to any person holding lien against a post under Govt. or under any other services.
3. The Centre reserves the right to fill-up or not to fill-up the posts and/or to call/or not to call any candidate for interview. The decision of the Centre is final.
4. Canvassing in any form by or on behalf of the candidate will disqualify him/her.

CV accompanied by copies of best research papers (five in case of Professor and three in case of Reader),attested copies of certificates, mark sheets, of all examinations passed, previous appointed orders and experience, etc. should reach the Director on or before 15.05.2013 positively either by post or by hand.
