Applications are invited for selection of 25 eligible candidates for the two weeks Certificate Training Programme on "Advance Research Methodology in Social Sciences". Any Research Scholars working in the Social Development Research with special focus on ST and SC communities in the Social Science subjects like Anthropology, Sociology, Social Work, Tribal Studies, Dalit Studies, Rural Development, Economics and Psychology can apply for the programme.

The candidates must have secured at least 60 per cent of marks in their Master Degree examinations. It is 55 per cent for the ST and SC candidates. Candidates, having JRF/NET and similar other qualifications or those who have already registered their names for doctoral works shall be given preference. Others however can also apply. Applications should reach in the office of the Commissioner-cum-Director, SCSTRTI by 5 P.M, of 25th April 2016.

Only short-listed candidates will be informed for participation in the course. Lodging and Boarding facilities will be arranged by the Institute for the participants only. To and fro bus or train fare (second class sleeper) will be provided to the outstation participants. Application format, TOR and other details of the course are available at the SCSTRTI's and NCDS's **website- www.scstrti.in** and www.ncds.nic.in respectively.

The filled in applications with requisite supporting documents of qualification and experiences in the prescribed format with a forwarding letter addressed to the Commissioner-cum-Director, SCSTRTI, CRPF Square, Bhubaneswar-751003 should be sent by post or deposited personally in the Office of SCSTRTI or through Email to SCSTRTI (scstrti@yahoo.co.in) on or before Dt. 25.04.2016 by 5.00PM positively. Applications received after the schedule date and time will not be entertained.

TERM OF REFERENCE

1. The title of the Training is Certificate Course in Advance Research Methodology.
2. The programme is being organized jointly by SCSTRTI and Nabakrushna Choudhury Center for Development Studies(NCDS), Bhubaneswar. The competent authorities of these two Institutes reserve the right to sponsor some institutional candidates (in addition to 25 candidates) and reject or accept any application without mentioning any reason thereof.
3. It has been decided to organize 2 number of programmes i.e. Level – I (15 days duration) and Level- II (21 days duration). Level- II Course is meant for those candidates who will qualify the Level-I Course.
4. The training classes will be held both at the Conference Halls of SCSTRTI as well as NCDS as per requirement.
5. This Course is residential in nature and there is no course fee for undergoing the training. Also reading materials both soft and hard copies relating to training will be provided free to the trainee-participants.
6. Duration of the Level–I programme is 2 weeks (13th -27th May, 2016 including one-day Field Study)
7. There is no course fee for this programme .Free boarding and lodging will be provided to the trainees by the organizing Institutions.
8. All the trainees will have to appear pre and post examinations followed by issuance of certificates.
9. The training will be imparted by expert from internal and external subject matter specialists.
10. No TA and DA and conveyance allowances will be provided to the trainees for joining and attending the training programme. Only transportation facility will be provided during the training course period through Institute’s Bus daily.
11. Please note that incomplete application will be rejected and no communication on the matter will be made thereof. The selection made by the Director SCSTRTI and NCDS for the Training Course is final and only the selected candidates will be intimated through their emails and telephone by 5th May, 2016 and the confirmation of the candidates should reach the office of SCSTRTI instantly by return mail, latest by 8th May, 2016 failing which the next candidates in the waiting list will be intimated to attend the training.
